Workshop Description:

The purpose of this conference is to highlight the latest evidence-based practice and strategies for the management of the patients with chronic lung disease in the pulmonary rehabilitation setting.

Objectives:

- 1. Define pulmonary rehabilitation and outpatient respiratory services including the differences in billing and coding, and inclusion criteria.
- 2. Discuss the Medicare and American Association of Cardiovascular and Pulmonary Rehabilitation (AACVPR) rules for the individualized treatment plan, the 30-day reassessment, and certification needs.
- 3. Define chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) including treatment and outcomes.
- 4. Describe the effects of vaping on lung health, how it compares to combustible smoke, the different tools that are used to determine the effects of vaping on lung health, and risks and considerations for patients using vaping devices.
- 5. Discuss the considerations for prescribing exercise for patients with chronic lung disease.
- 6. Discuss navigating insurance for respiratory coverage including testing, documentation, and prescriptions for oxygen therapy, continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP)/bi level positive airway pressure (BiPAP) and non-invasive ventilation (NIV). Describe options for oxygen therapy and CPAP/BiPAP equipment. Discuss desensitization techniques for CPAP/BiPAP.


